Executive Director Report

What has changed since I shared what hunger relief looks like in Pierce County with you last year? While media is telling us the economy has improved, and for some it has, you will not hear that from those who are in a line at a food bank or meal site for the first time in their lives. The need has gone up 11% since 2011. To meet this need we are distributing 17% more food in the same time-frame.

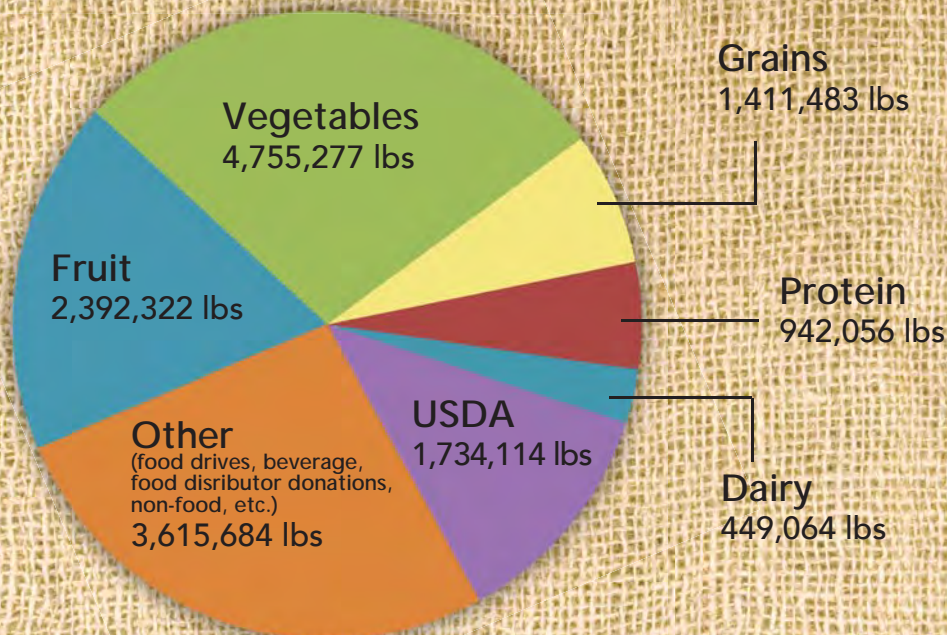
Who are these new faces? Mr. Adams once volunteered and was a

monthly donor to the food bank in his church. Over the last few years he lost his pension and has had increased medical costs. Now, he is a recipient of the food he once handed out. Embarrassed at first, he is grateful for the healthy nutritious food he receives weekly.

The Butlers have three children, are hard workers and were making it. Mr. Butler lost his job when the company he was working for had to cut back. Mrs. Butler's hours were reduced. They can pay their rent and get some assistance with heating bills. Without the food from the food bank they have no idea how they would make it. Unemployment and food stamps won't get you through the month.

I could fill this report with stories of folks just like you and me who find themselves at a crossroad they never imagined. The good news is that thanks to you and all our donors and volunteers, EFN was able to distribute 15.3 million pounds of food from our warehouse in 2014.

We have very successful partnerships with many local companies that help us secure donated food. We partner with Rotary First Harvest and Northwest Harvest to secure healthy, highly nutritious, purchased shelf-stable food and produce.

Seventy-nine percent of the food that EFN distributes is healthy and nutritious. The rest is likely to be healthy as well, but we don't track every nutrition label on each donated can of food. How do we do it? Each week we receive an average of three or more truckloads of seasonal produce such as potatoes, onions, apples and cherries. Next, EFN invests \$450,000 annually to cooperatively purchase healthy food staples such as rice, beans, oats, canned vegetables and lean proteins like ground turkey. Finally, we distribute produce from EFN's Mother Earth Farm, food from the USDA and large donations from grocery outlets and other food distributors.

Last year, 1,421,417 client visits were made to Pierce County food programs in our network. We are very proud that we are keeping pace with the need, and even prouder to say that we do not sacrifice quality in the name of quantity. We are there for families and individuals like the Butlers and Mr. Adams.

With continued federal cuts to the dollars available to programs (such as EFN) and the individuals themselves, your participation will continue to be the safety net for our neighbors in need. The system of generosity we have in Pierce County extends from the gardener growing an extra row to our many volunteers to the financial support we get from caring and generous individuals, businesses and corporations and government entities. On behalf of those who need it most we thank you for helping us provide healthy nutritious food.

Mother Earth Farm

Q and A with Farm Manager Anika Moran



Q: Anika, how does it feel to be the new Farm Manager out at Mother Earth Farm?

A: It feels fantastic. I've been farming organically since 2009 and have worked with EFN for two years, so am ready to take on the 2015 growing season! I had the chance to work a second year as the Assistant Farm Manager in 2014 with Canyon Little, the former manager, and the season passed in a flash of kale and tomatoes.

Q: Were there any big developments at Mother Earth Farm last year?

A: We were able to put up a high tunnel at the farm - it's a protected space a lot like a greenhouse, but we plant directly into the ground. It allowed us to grow heat-loving crops over the summer and cold-tolerant vegetables over the winter. We also added a few more food banks to our distribution, expanding the reach of our fresh produce across Pierce County.

Q: You're growing vegetables over the winter?

A: Yes! For the first time at Mother Earth Farm we are continuing to distribute vegetables throughout the winter. We are able to have carrots, parsnips, scallions, and all sorts of greens in the ground year round.

Q: What are you excited about for 2015?

A: I'm looking forward to working with all the folks who will help us grow great food. We'll have a new Assistant Farm Manager, a fresh crew from the Washington Corrections Center for Women, and lots of volunteers. I'm hoping to see some familiar faces! We also have a few new events planned, so stay posted for some summer fun out at the farm.

A monthly donation of \$25 provides 300 lbs of fresh produce to food bank clients.





2015 Events at Mother Earth Farm

Draft Horse Plow - April 4, 2015

Join us out on the farm this April for our annual draft horse plow! You'll have a chance to watch horses till and fertilize our fields, check out the greenhouse while it's full of starts, and admire the start of spring in our orchard. Bring the whole family!

Volunteer Supported Agriculture (VSA) Program - Starts April 25, 2015

Help sustain the work of Mother Earth Farm for the 2015 growing season while getting an education in organic gardening! This new program will offer training and classes to volunteers who would like to learn how to grow food organically. In exchange, volunteers will be asked to work a minimum number of hours at the farm throughout the summer. Volunteers will not only learn basic skills such as planting, weeding, and harvesting, but also more specialized knowledge in composting, plant nutrition needs, and integrated pest management. Education will be both hands-on and discussion based, and can be applied to home gardens, too!

Sign up for either a half-share (6 volunteer hours per month) or full-share (12 volunteer hours per month). Full-share volunteers receive a special treat at the end! Prior gardening experience is not necessary. The minimum age to participate is 16.

Youth Days - June 6 and August 28, 2015

Mother Earth Farm will be hosting our second summer of Youth Days. Youth Days are an opportunity to come taste veggies, help us care for our farm, and talk about important issues in our community. These half-day events are for participants ages 16 and younger and their families or youth group.

Commemoration of Doreen Johnson, Farm Donor - July 25, 2015

Please come help us celebrate Doreen Johnson, a member of our community who stepped up fifteen years ago to offer the Emergency Food Network eight acres to grow food for food banks. Though Doreen has passed, her legacy lives on in her family's continued support of Mother Earth Farm. To mark our appreciation and the fifteenth year of this relationship, this July we'll be dedicating our bountiful orchard to her memory.

Weed Dating - Saturday, August 12, 2015

Get dirty and meet someone! Mother Earth Farm is hosting our first ever weed dating, a chance to help out your community and connect with new friends... or more! The afternoon will start with a tour of the farm and after a brief demo, we'll divide and conquer those pesky weeds, rotating sections so that everyone has a chance to chat. We'll end the day with a free happy hour and a big thanks to all. The minimum age to participate is 21.

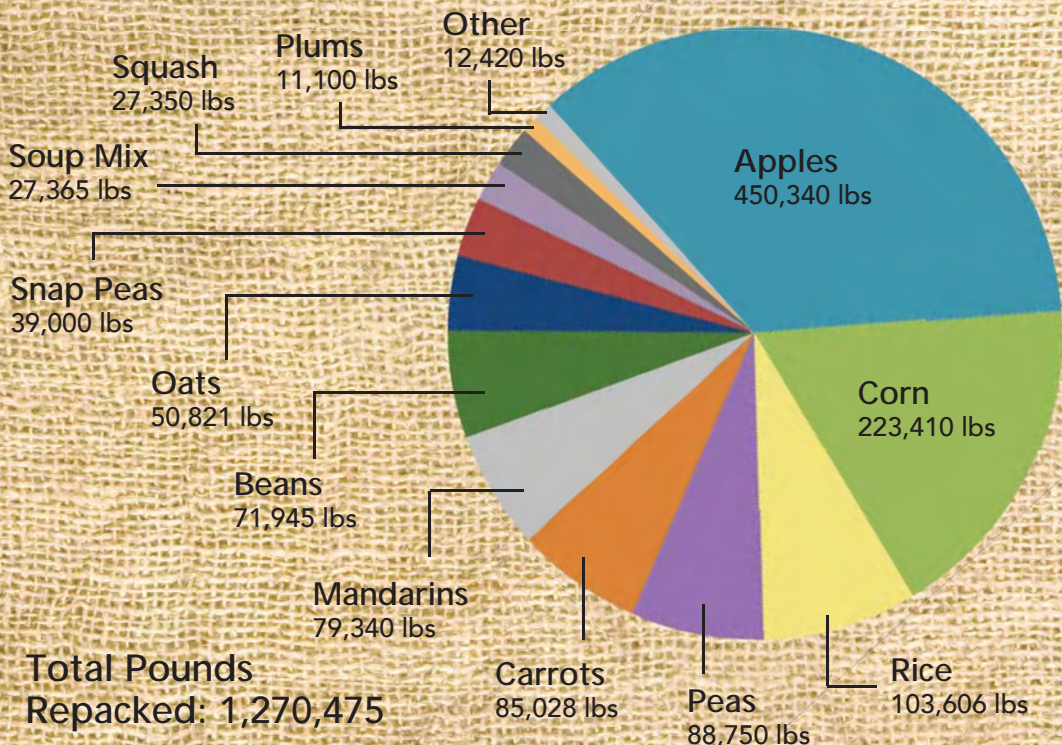


